### What is S.A.L.T.?

S.A.L.T. is a group of youth selected by the youth director in response to applications. Your job as a S.A.L.T. member would be to discuss upcoming activities of the youth, evaluated past activities, and say if it is time to move on from (or continue) participating in them, and in doing this you will represent your youth group, church community and God in a positive manor. You will be called upon to help the youth group at St. Luke's grow. Also, it is your responsibility to set the bar of behavioral standards at and away from St. Luke's activities.

### Who can be chosen?

Based on the applications you fill out the youth council will be comprised of approximately: 2 youth from each grade level.

### When will we meet?

Depending on the needs of the group and its members we will meet from 7:15-8:15 one or two Sundays every eight weeks. You must be a member of St. Luke's to be in leadership. The UM Book of Discipline highly encourages youth to be on church councils. These typically meet on Monday nights.
